



Curriculum Overview for Parents

English

Children will be reading the book 'The Wild Robot'. We will continue to develop our fluency when reading. We will write a first person narrative in the voice of Roz.



History

In the summer term, Year 3 students will learn about the Romans, focusing on their daily life, invasions, settlements in Britain, and lasting impact on society and culture.

DT

The children will be making their own pencil cases/purses using materials to stitch together.

Science

Children will develop their understanding of plants including looking at roots and shoots.



Music

Children will be continuing to learn how to play their recorders. We will be looking at different tempos.
