



Curriculum Overview for Parents

Year: Year 6
Term: Spring 1 2026

English

In English we will be reading 'There's a Boy in the Girls Bathroom' and producing both narrative and non-fiction pieces based on this novel. We will also be analysing the visual literacy, Francis and the poem, The Highwayman. Our reading sessions will focus on retrieving information from what we read and making appropriate inferences with evidence to support our reasons.

History

Year 6 will be learning about the impact of medical breakthroughs in History and how that has helped to extend the life expectancy. We will understand how an accidental discovery helped to save millions of people.

Art

In art we will be practising how we can use colour, texture and pattern to look at fashion and design in the past and present day.

Music

In music this half term the children will be learning about different styles of music from around the world.

RE

In RE we will be learning about both religious and non-religious beliefs and how they can help us to learn what is right and wrong.

Maths

In maths we will be learning about the relationships between fractions, decimals and percentages as well as how to solve problems involving ratio. We will also be working hard to improve our arithmetic skills and how to approach reasoning style questions in preparation for our SATS.

Science

In science we will be learning about electricity and how to create different types of circuits. We will be investigating how the brightness of a bulb can be altered by changing different components in the circuit.

PE

In PE this half term we will be developing flexibility, strength, technique, control and balance while creating a sequence of movements and holds within gymnastics. The children will be performing and self-assessing their own performances.
