
Year 5 - STEM Day at RAF Cosford



What have our year groups been focusing on this week and what the focus is next week....?



Year 1

This week, in Maths we are using the crocodile symbols to show which number is greater than or less than a given number.

Next week, we will be reading the story "A Train Ride" written by June Crebbin.

Year 2

This week, we have continued to write about the book 'The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark' by Jill Tomlinson. We have been writing about crackling campfires.

Next week, in Maths we are going to practise adding numbers together.





Year 3

This week, in English we have looked at holiday brochures. We have travelled to Skara Brae and have broken down text to understand the brochure better using symbols.

Next week, in Science we will be looking at how fossils are formed.

Year 4

This week, in Maths we are comparing numbers up to 10,000. Next week, we are continuing to study 'The Iron Man', by Ted Hughes.





Year 5

This week, we enjoyed our visit to RAF Cosford where we enjoyed learning about Forces in Science.

Next week, we will be continuing our English work on the book 'I believe in unicorns' by Michael Morpurgo.

Year 6

This week, in science we have investigated bird beaks and how they have adapted over time to help the birds survive in their habitats. We made detailed observations and practised using a variety of equipment.

Next week, we start our new non-fiction writing unit based on Charles

Darwin's The Origin Of The Species. We will be linking what we have learnt in science on adaptation and using this to create a non-chronological report.






