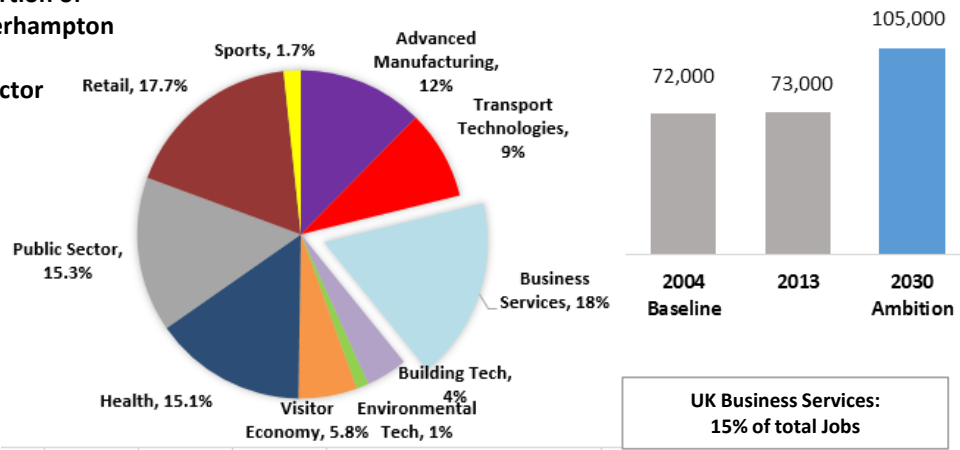

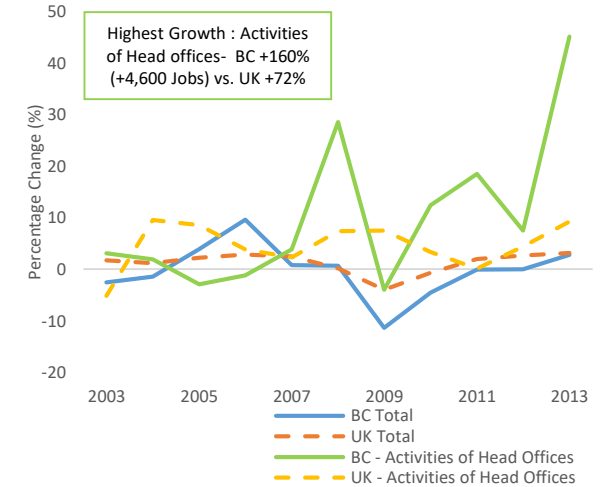
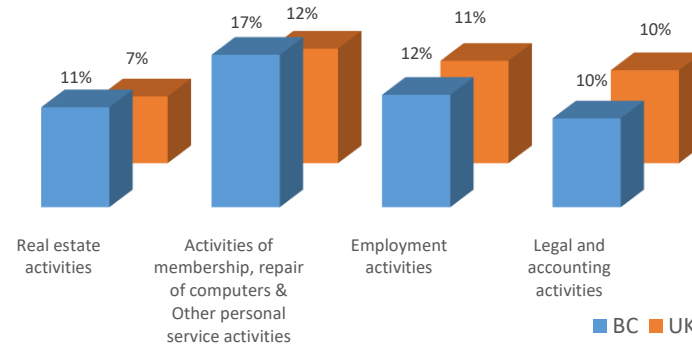

### Proportion of Jobs Sub-sectors: BC & UK 2013



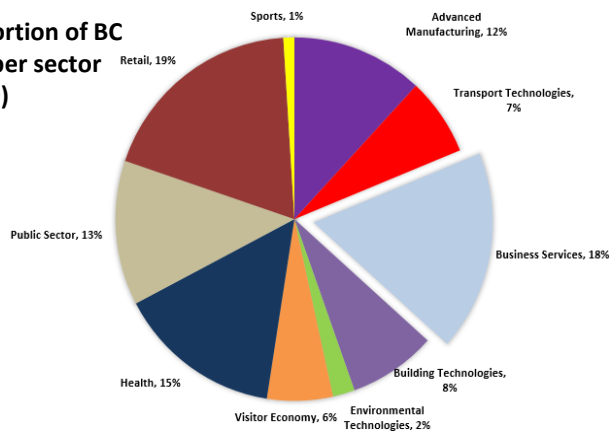
